Within this framework, public research institutions such as EPST, EPIC, Universities, University hospitals as well as foundations can apply, in general for up to 100% of so called "marginal" costs. This list is not comprehensive and funding rates vary.	Eligible costs and rates of funding depend on the type of partners. Among others, eligible costs may include the following: personnel costs; equipment costs; consumables and animal costs; travel and subsistence costs; sub-contracting costs. Subcontracting costs cannot exceed 50% of the total costs of a partner.
